## TIPS & REMINDERS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR?



- School start: 8:45 a.m. for **ALL** students.

- K-6 students: dismiss at 3:00 p.m. on Mon., Tues., Thurs., and Fri.
- 7th & 8th graders are dismissed at 3:50 p.m. on Mon., Tues., Thurs., and Fri.
- Wednesday, K-6 students are dismissed at 2:00pm and 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders are dismissed at 2:50pm
- All students at Roberts Naylor have the opportunity to receive free breakfast and lunch everyday. There is no need to fill out applications
- Always make sure that your student is in uniform, if students are not in uniform parents will receive a phone call in the morning.
- All middle school students (5th - 8th) use clear backpacks.



- K-4 students can use regular backpacks
- Cell phones: Students are **not** permitted to keep cell phones on their person once they come to school. They can turn it into the office or place it in a pouch in their backpack.
- Drinks: Students can only bring water to school or a small juice with lunch. No soft drinks, energy drinks etc. in the morning or during classes
- Drop off will resume as it has in a traditional manner. Students will be allowed to play on playground.
