- 1. Call Meeting to Order at 4:15 via Zoom.
- 2. Review of Agenda/Minutes Since most members are new, we did not approve the minutes of the last meeting last year.
- 3. Call to the Audience –
- 3. Action Items
 - Approval to use Undesignated Tax Credit funds to pay for sports fees. We have asked to approve the use of up to \$1000 out of Undesignated Tax Credit to pay for sports fees. Fees are \$30 per student to play a sport. We will be asking students to pay the fee or at least part of it. Students who cannot afford the fee can also fill out a request from EEF for assistance.

- This money would cover anything that is not coved by the student or EEF. Clarita made a motion to spend up to \$1000 for sports fees. Ms. Korankye seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
- Approval to use Undesignated funds to purchase radios for the school.- We have been asked for up to \$3000 radios. These radios are needed for safety of the students here at school. This is the last year that we are able to use tax credit money to pay for them. Radios cost around \$250 each. Ms. R made a motion to spend up to \$3000 for the purchase of radios for the school. Mr. Lewis seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- Approval to use Undesignated Tax Credit funds to pay for the Wright Flight Program. We have been asked to approve up to \$800 for the Wright Flight Program. Wright Flight is an aviation curriculum that has been offered to 5th graders since we were at Roberts. It allows students who have earned the privilege both academically and behaviorally to participate. Students stay after school for about 10 weeds learning about aviation. This gives students the experiences to see that there are many opportunities that they can achieve in the future. The class will be taught by Mr. Ross Gillis again this year. The cost depends on the number of students who participate. Mrs. R explained what the program was. Mrs. R made a motion to approve up to \$800 for the Wright Flight Program. Mr. Dee seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously

- Teacher Staffing Updates Mrs. R shared that we just hired our two international teachers for grades 2 and 4. We will also be getting a new FTE which will give us a new ELA teacher in Middle School.
- Boys Scouts at Roberts/Naylor Mr. Dee is interested in getting Boy Scouts at Naylor. He has been talking to Catalina Council and is trying to get volunteers to help build Cub Scout packs. Cub Scouts are grades K-5. If we can get enough volunteers we could hopefully be able to start in January. We would need to find volunteers to lead the packs. He will keep us updated.
