### TIPS & REMINDERS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR

- School start: 8:45 a.m. for ALL students.
- K-6 students: dismiss at 3:00 p.m. on Mon., Tues., Thurs., and Fri.
- 7th & 8th graders are dismissed at 3:50 p.m. on Mon., Tues., Thurs., and Fri.
- Wednesday, K-6 students are dismissed at 2:00pm and 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders are dismissed at 2:50pm
- All students at Roberts Naylor have the opportunity to receive free breakfast and lunch everyday. There is no need to fill out applications
- Always make sure that your student is in uniform, if students are not in uniform parents will receive a phone call in the morning.
- All middle school students (6th - 8th) use clear backpacks.

### Reminders

- Breakfast and lunch are Free to all students everyday
- Students will be needing to show I.D's if they are riding a bus. Please make sure our student has their I.D each day. We will provide them.
- 6th-8th grades use clear/Mesh back packs due to safety for all.
- Please make sure you sign your student's computer form.
- Our dress down days for \$1 are every Friday. If we don't have school on a Friday, then we don't have dress down for that week. Information sheets were sent with your student.
- It is very hot, please send your student with a water bottle.

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### Continued TIPS & REMINDERS FOR THE SCHOOL YEAR

- K-5 students can use regular backpacks
- Cell phones: Students are **not** permitted to keep cell phones on their person once they come to school. They can turn it into the office or place it in a pouch in their backpack.
- Drinks: Students can only bring water to school or a small juice with lunch. No soft drinks, energy drinks etc. in the morning or during classes
