Attention all **current 7th** graders along with parents and guardians. We currently have a very successful program when students enter 8th grade. Our students have the opportunity to go to Palo Verde High school in the morning and take the following classes for High School credit. They take Spanish, Algebra and Biology. These classes are taken in 8th grade and allow our students to attend any high school in TUSD and receive credits before they start their freshman year. There are a few criteria that students must have in order to qualify for the program their 8th grade year.

-Must pass a short Algebra quiz

-Commit to a 95% attendance rate

-Commit to focusing on grades and passing with a C or higher
