- 2. Review of Agenda/Minutes Clarita made a motion to accept the minutes as written. Amanda seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.

- 4. Action Items:
 - SY 2024-2025 Meeting Dates: Clara made a motion to accept the meeting dates for the 2024-2025 SY: December 12th, February 27th, and April 17th. Amanda seconded the motion. Passed unanimously.
 - Dress Code updates With winter coming up it will begin to cool off, students will be wearing sweatshirts and want to wear hoodies. Mrs. R wanted to bring to site council for 6th-8th to not wear hoodies as there have issues with students using hoodies to hide Vape pens and other paraphernalia. - Approval of Roberts-Naylor Library Dedication for Mrs. Lugo Clara presented the dedication of the school library to Mrs. Lugo. She has collected six letters from staff who have worked with Mrs. Lugo. Clara will continue to collect character letters through October. Mrs. R will present to TUSD board by December. Currently less than \$500 designated for sports. Amanda made a motion to move \$2500 from Undesignated tax funds to sports. Seconded by Sam Elmer. Passes unanimously.
